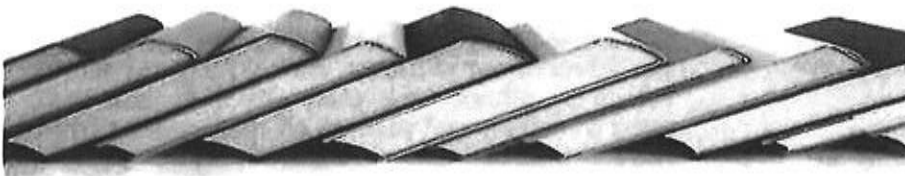
Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD)
