Dear Driver Education Student/Parent:

The following letter contains information on the Enderlin Driver Education program. State guidelines require thirty classroom hours, six hours behind-the-wheel, and six hours of observation for students wishing to get a behind-the-wheel certificate. A letter grade and 1/4 credit will be given to pupils that complete/pass the course. The class is not required to graduate from the Enderlin Area School. Therefore, it is not mandatory for students to take the course.

After completing the course, students receive a certificate of completion or a certificate of training, that will allow them the opportunity to get their driver license or test for their driver's license. However, they must be at least 14 years of age to drive with the instructor, a permit is not mandatory. Teens 14 years of age that apply for a permit will be required to hold that permit for a minimum of 12 months. Fifty hours of supervised driving experience is required. Teens 15 years of age will be required to hold the permit until age 16 or a minimum of six months, whichever is longer. The 50 hours of supervised driving experience will apply to them as well. Normally, after taking the driver education course, there is a reduction in auto insurance.

Students may not miss **ANY** classroom instruction - no exceptions made. All appointments/vacations must be done on days other than when the course is offered. Minimum requirements for the course requires students to be in attendance for thirty hours - that is why no exceptions can be made for students missing class.

Pupils who currently have permits will be given the opportunity to drive first whenever possible. Students do not need a permit to take the behind-the-wheel portion, but it is **RECOMMENDED** having one.

PUPILS MUST BE 14 YEARS OLD TO TAKE THE BEHIND-THE-WHEEL TRAINING AND WITH A BIRTHDAY ON OR BEFORE **AUGUST 1 UNLESS OTHER ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY INSTRUCTORS.**
