

**MAPLE VALLEY SMART RESTART MODELS**

**2020-2021**

**PLAN A:** (This is the Model Maple Valley will be in to start the school year).

Plan A will bring students back to school with a modified hybrid start as outlined in the SMART RESTART Plan. Following are some important points:

Week 1: Modified Hybrid (K-6 Modified, 7-12 Modified)

Wednesday, August 19<sup>th</sup>

Group A K-12 will be in School

Thursday, August 20<sup>th</sup>

Group B K12 will be in School

Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup>

No Students Teachers only

Week 2: Modified Hybrid (K-6 Modified, 7-12 Full Session)

Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup> through Friday August 28<sup>th</sup>

Groups K-6 Will be in School

(Group A in Session: August 25,27)

(Group B in Session: August 26, 28)

All 7-12 Students will be in School

Week 3: K-12 All students will be back in school (August 31<sup>st</sup>)

Normal Schedule but will modify times and locations of where students eat.

**PLAN B: HYBRID MODEL**

The hybrid model will still have students in school, but it will be by designated group on alternating days, i.e. Group A will be on Campus M, W, F and Group B will be on campus T/Th of that same week. The next week Group A will be on Campus on T,Th and Group B will be on campus M,W,F. This model will follow that pattern until the status of the model changes back to PLAN A or moves to PLAN C. Regarding classes when students are not scheduled to be on campus, the protocol will be for those students to follow that same daily schedule as if they were in school and attend classes at home online.

**PLAN C: FULL DISTANCE LEARNING**

If Maple Valley moves to plan C, we will implement the plan used last Spring. The plan has been modified and updated, the major change to be aware of is:

\*All classes will follow their regular schedule. Teachers will be on campus and will teach lessons online during their regularly scheduled class times. All students are expected to attend classes (ZOOM) as if they were on campus. We will remain in this mode until further notification.
